



## Kindergarten 2011-2012 Shopping List

Here is a list of items our class needs. Most of these supplies can be purchased at office supply or craft stores. Also, check your child's classroom for a "Wish List" of items to purchase for the classroom.

### Supplies for Classroom Art Program:

- ▶ 1 pkg Crayola washable markers, fat tipped
- ▶ 1 tray of watercolors (true primary colors are important, no sparkles or glitter, Prang brand recommended)
- ▶ 1 box of colored pencils (RoseArt is a good brand.)
- ▶ 1 tablet watercolor paper
- ▶ 3 white poster boards (3/\$1 at Dollar Tree)
- ▶ Cardstock (Heavy weight paper)
- ▶ 1 pkg (approx 3) of fine tipped sharpies (black)

### Classroom Supplies:

- ▶ 2 packages of glue sticks (Elmers brand please, it works the best)
- ▶ 1 package of **solid** construction paper, any color
- ▶ 2 packages of Clorox wipes
- ▶ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer w/pump
- ▶ 1 box of Kleenex (we may ask for more during the year)
- ▶ 1 tablet of tracing paper

### Additional Materials Donation Request:

The school has purchased materials for your student. These include Primary Phonics, Explode the Code, and Spelling workbooks. In addition, teachers prepare student notebooks for various subject matter. Any classroom donations to offset these costs are appreciated! Thank you for supporting our charter school!

**Personal Supplies:** The following supplies will be used by your child and will go home with your child at the end of the year. *Please label them with your child's name.*

- ▶ Slippers (The slippers should be in good condition, simple, comfortable, fit well, and be easy to take on and off. We also ask that they have no characters, animal faces, feathers, lights, or other distracting qualities.)
- ▶ A change of clothes (If you feel your child may need this, place them in a zip-lock bag with your child's name on it and they will be kept in the classroom.)
- ▶ Backpack (We ask that these also have no characters, or other distracting qualities. Please none with handles and wheels, thank you. Make sure your child brings this everyday)

**Lunch:** We will be eating lunch in the cafeteria but will use this as a time to exercise grace and courtesy. Please provide your child with a lunch box that does not have characters on it. In the lunch box please place a cloth napkin that your child will use as a place mat for their meal. This napkin will need to be marked with your child's name and laundered regularly. Lunch should consist of healthy items: a protein, carbohydrate, and fruit and/or vegetable. Please avoid excessively processed foods and sweets. Snack will be provided in class every day, so keep this in mind when you are deciding on portion size. Hot lunch is available in the cafeteria and can be purchased in the office or by sending lunch money into class with your child in the morning.

**Miscellaneous Materials:** Check in the classroom at the Meet and Greet for a *Wish List*. There will be a variety of items that we will need purchased, copied, and/or assembled.

**CMP Field trip t-shirts:** For safety and easy ID, we encourage the children to wear a burgundy CMP t-shirt for our field trips. They are available for purchase in the office.
