Please initial each item (except composition books, dry erase pens and Sharpie pens) with child's first and last initial using a sharpie pen as noted.

back pack

lunch box/bag (no cartoon characters)

5 -Mead, **BLACK and WHITE**, college rule, hard cover (NO designs please) composition books - Please put name only in pencil - I have labels

1 - Sharpie pen (extra fine tip)

2 - packs 24 #2 pencils (standard yellow) - initials towards eraser end with sharpie

2 - packs **CRAYOLA brand** 12 colored pencils (try and find one that has a **PINK** color included) - initials towards end with sharpie

1 - pack **CRAYOLA brand** thin colored markers - initials towards end with sharpie

2 - hand held sharpeners - initials with sharpie

1 - pack of 25 pencil top erasers or equivalent

3 - glue sticks - initials with sharpie

1 - protractor - initials with sharpie

1 - scissors (adult) - initials with sharpie

1 - each: black, red, blue, green thin tip dry erase pens

3 - large poster boards (white)

1 - tray of water color paints - initials with sharpie

All supplies can be found at almost any large chain store and right now the prices are REALLY good! Any questions or concerns just let me know! Please try and have students bring all materials either to the Meet and Greet or the first day of school.

The following are shared supplies that we use in the classroom on a daily basis. Please, if possible, bring in one of each (or more if you chose to). We will need these supplies throughout the entire school year.

1 - box of tissue
