- ___ 1 Package colored pencils (with all the fancy colors)
- ___ 1 USB drive
- ___ 1 Large pack of dry erase markers (Put inside a clean, old sock. This works as storage and as an eraser)
- ___ 1 Gridded composition book
- ___ 3 Lined composition books
- ___ 1 Reusable water bottle
- ___ 1 Large clipboard
- ___ 3 Tri-fold boards (keep in a safe place at home for upcoming projects)
