Required Attendance Procedures

Reporting Absences:

All absences and late arrivals must be called in by a parent/guardian prior to the start of EACH instructional day.

Late Arrivals:

When arriving late, the parent/guardian must sign in through the school office and obtain a tardy slip to admit the child to class. Once the child has been signed in, the child may proceed to class.

Child Booster Seat NEW LAW in Effect January 1, 2012

Children 7 years & younger who are less than 57" tall (4'9") MUST be in a child restraint (booster seat) & MUST sit in the back seat

However, children ages 8-15 or at least 57" can ride without a booster seat.
