

Amethyst Wordly Wise Directions

Vocabulary is the currency of language and communication. Wordly Wise will be our source of reference to expand and strengthen our understanding and use of vocabulary words. Also, if you happen to come across a word you don't know then following our regular lessons for Wordly Wise will be an excellent way to increase your word expertise!

The lessons will extend throughout a **two-week session**. They will begin with creating flash cards for each vocabulary word. The flash cards will include the word, part of speech, and definition. Then the next day of work will begin to be recorded on a worksheet from class. This worksheet is to be stapled or glued onto the first page of the new lesson. We will check off your progress **DAILY** so be sure to bring your Wordly Wise book back to school **EVERYDAY**.

Week 1

Monday: Create flash cards for each word – include word, part of speech and definition

Tuesday: Complete Lesson A and record list of synonyms and antonyms for each word on the worksheet

Wednesday: Complete Lesson B and record the etymology and word forms (use dictionaries or find online)

Thursday: Complete Lesson C and write sentences for words 1 – 5

Week 2

Monday: Complete book exercise D and write sentences for words 6 – 10

Tuesday: Complete book exercise E and write sentences for words 11 – 15

Wednesday: Review flash cards with adult and review synonyms, antonyms, etymology, and word forms

Thursday: Review exercises A, B, C, D and E – Check your answers
