For the Third Grade Book Report, due the week of October 24th, we are asking that the children read and report on a non-fiction book relating to an animal from your Continent for the Continent Party. Your student has two (2) possible projects from which to choose:

- A Book Mobile – Different scenes and characters are represented through the mobile. Please do not photocopy any portion of the book, but rather allow/encourage your student to draw the different parts.
- A Diorama – A scene is recreated in a box (shoebox). Paper drawings, painting, small toy figures, or handcrafted objects are used to create the scene.

Also required is a written form that is attached. Please use correct spelling and grammar. **Information or articles found on the Internet are not acceptable for this project.**

Obviously there are several **key pieces of information that each project must contain: title, author, and illustrator.** A rubric has been attached for your convenience. We encourage you to find a book that has a quiz for accelerated reader. To find a quiz just go to www.arbookfind.com to search book titles. If you have any questions about any of these books, don't hesitate to ask. This is not meant to be stress producing, but rather, a fun project for you and your student to do together. We are looking forward to the reports.
