Parents are Vital to Every Child's Success!

The following are some suggestions of practices that help young people do well in school:

- Everyone in the family has a household responsibility, at least one chore that must be done on time
- Have regular times for members of the family to eat, sleep, play, work, and study
- Schoolwork and reading come before play, TV, or even other work
- Praise your child for good schoolwork and helpful actions, sometimes in front of other people
