Personal Supplies to Bring to Class (please label items with your child's name)

- 1 large zipper binder
- 1 pack of dividers
- 1 zipper pencil pouch (if binder doesn't have one)
- 1 box of pencils (or mechanical pencil with .05 or .07 lead)
- 1 eraser*
- 1 pack of colored pencils (24 pk)*
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener (with case for shavings)
- 1 cloth placement
- 4 dry erase markers * (blue and black preferred)
- 1 athletic sock or handkerchief (to wipe with)
- 2-3 glue sticks
- Correction tape (white out)
- 1 ruler
- 1 pair of junior or adult scissors
- 3 lined composition books*
- 3 pack lined paper*
- 1 pack graph paper
- 2 graph composition books

* items will need to be replenished 1 or more times during the year. It would be cost effective if you purchased extra items now while they are on sale.

Helpful Supplies to Bring to Class (please label items with your child's name)

- 1 Flash drive to save and transport computer work
- 1 Reusable water bottle
- 1 Clipboard
- 1 pair of slippers for work time
