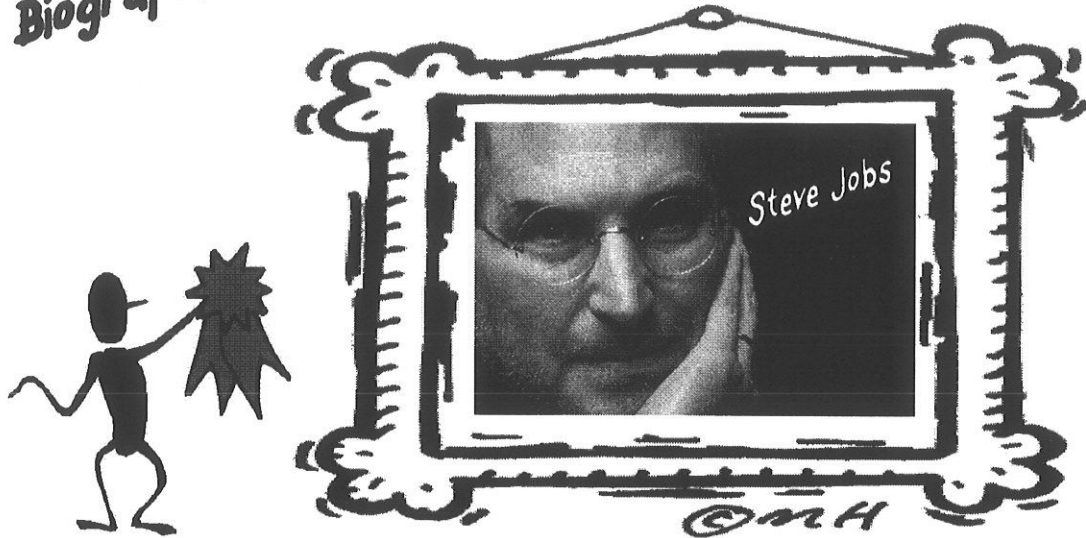


"The Award" 2/3 Biography Book Report
