Our tour will begin with a wagon ride through the apple orchard. We will learn about apple ranching from blossom through harvest. On our way back, we will pass by the duck pond and end by the apple barn and bake shop.

Inside the apple barn, we will tour their kitchen where we will see how apples are made into delectable bakery goodies. A fresh apple donut, cool apple juice, and a crisp apple will be served to everyone in our group.

After the tour, students will get to play in the hay bale maze with chaperones supervising. Each student will also get to choose a small pumpkin to bring home.
