

FAIRY TALE BOOK REPORT-DUE FRIDAY, DECEMBER 9TH

For the next book report, you get to choose a fairy tale. Many students have fairy tales that are their favorite; we'd like to encourage them to choose one that they have not yet read. A big part of this report is presenting the moral, or lesson, of the story, so that should be considered when selecting a book.

ASSIGNMENT

You are going to have fun with this assignment! For this book report, you get to make a mystery bag (or other creative holder) full of 4-6 items that somehow represent your fairy tale. They can represent a character, the setting, the story, or the moral of the story. When you present your items to the class, it will help explain the book and make your fellow students want to read it! Items in the bag can be anything from something you made to a picture from a magazine. Let your imagination run wild and find a great way to present your book! If you are having a tough time finding a book, a Google search "list of fairy tales" will provide an endless list of options.

PRESENTATION

When we present these book reports, you will be asked to do the following:

1. State the title and author of your book
2. Tell the audience what the moral of your story is
3. Introduce your grab bag items and explain how they relate to the story

While doing this you will be giving the audience an idea of what happened in the story and helping them understand the moral of the story.
