- 3 prong **plastic*** portfolios. One each of the following colors: Green, Yellow, Red, Purple
- * It is extremely important that your child has the plastic rather than the paper folders. The plastic is much more durable and should last through the school year.**
- 1 lunch box (no logos) with reusable food storage containers
- 1 reusable water bottle
