Care of Environment

- ~ Totebags only (reusable shopping bags work well too)

Dress Code

- ~ We encourage solids, stripes or floral patterns (see CMP dress code)
- ~ One small picture or writing is allowed, if appropriate and smaller than 3 x 5 card
- ~ Shoes must have a back/strap across heel (flip-flops are not safe)

Attendance

- ~ Call the office in the AM when absent
- ~ Tardy slips are required after 8:30am

Drop off and Pick up

- ~ Class begins at 8:30am; allow time to put belongings away and for your child to transition
- ~ Kindergarteners are dismissed at 2:00 - picked up at playground gate with Club M staff
- ~ First Graders are dismissed at 3:00 - picked up at the Mimosa side gate
- ~ You can expect us to be outside about 5 minutes after class is dismissed
