

School Supply List: 2011-2012 Mimosa (K/1) Class

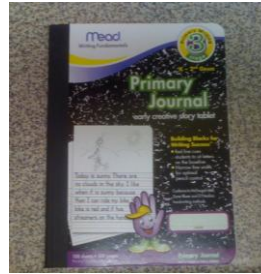
