## A Note From the Teachers:

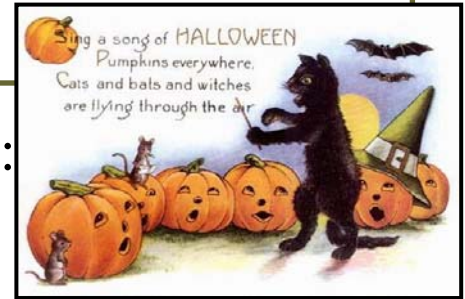
