



2/3 Aerospace Museum and American River Exploration Field Trip: Dec 8th

Dear 2/3 Families,

We have planned an exciting field trip to the California Aerospace Museum. Students will be led through the museum and the airpark on a tour that will illustrate the incredible world of science, aeronautics, and our great history of flying! After the tour is over, ***provided that the weather holds up***, we will then head over to the American River Access Point off of Watt Avenue for lunch and a river exploration activity. **Ideally, each class will need between 7 to 10 chaperones that can accommodate 3-4 students in their vehicle. As per the CMP guidelines, chaperones must have all paperwork submitted and up to date to participate. Remember, some forms must be submitted yearly, and may need to be resubmitted.**

The itinerary for the fieldtrip is as follows:

8:00am Leave CMP SS Campus (We are traveling with the rush-hour traffic)

9:30am-11:30am Tour of CA. Aerospace Museum

We will be touring the Exhibition Hall and the Airpark at the CA. Aerospace Museum. Students will learn about the history and science of flight, as well as observe and walk through actual airplanes.

11: 50am Drive to American River Access Point down Watt Ave. for Lunch and River Exploration Activities

We will relax and enjoy lunch outdoors. Afterwards, we will have a structured river exploration activity in which chaperones will lead their groups on a plant and animal scavenger hunt.

Students will draw and label plants found around the river, and draw and describe animals and insects (also from the river area) that they have learned about in Botany and Zoology.
