Dear CMP Families,

CMP is currently in negotiations with the San Juan Unified School District (SJUSD) to open a new campus in Orangevale. The Coleman campus will serve students K/6th grade with an emphasis on primary grades (K-3). It has been CMP's dream to return to the Orangevale area, dating back to our re-location from the church campus in 2004. We are anticipating a final decision from SJUSD regarding CMP's usage of the Coleman Campus within the next month or two.

The campus will serve a combination of transfer and new students. Opening a new site will allow our American River Campus to maintain an enrollment closer to our goal of 300 students. Presently the American River campus has an enrollment in excess of 400 students.

A few of the benefits of opening this additional campus are:

- Addressing the over-enrollment at the American River Campus
- Offering tuition-free Montessori elementary education to the families currently enrolled at local Montessori preschools
- Offering current CMP families a campus located closer to their homes in the Orangevale, Folsom, Roseville and Placer County areas

The American River and Carmichael campuses will continue to offer quality Middle School Programs to our Orangevale/Folsom students.

We will be sending out an 'interest survey' next week as part of our data-gathering process as we seek to fully serve our CMP families.
