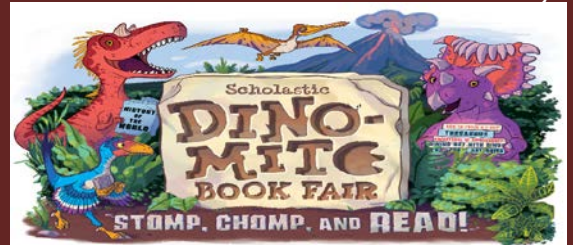

## Classroom Coin Drive Starts Today!

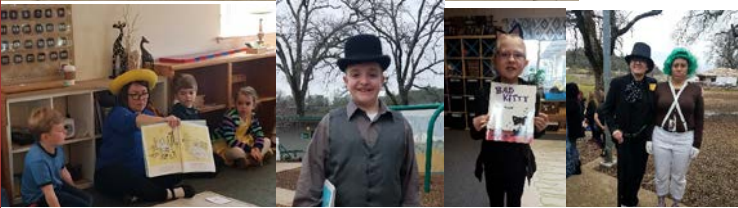

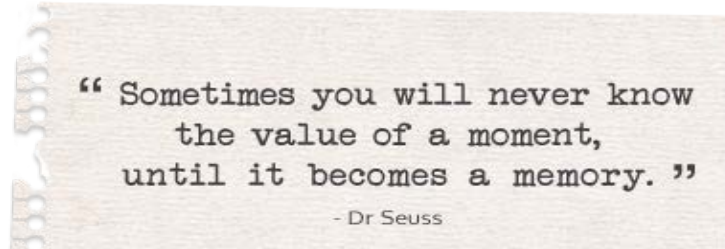
